**RE: South Hook – COMAH\* Alarm Test**

I am writing to inform you that as part of our quarterly safety communications we will be testing two sirens on **Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> April 2010**. One is the COMAH\* Alarm and the other is the All Clear Alarm. No action need be taken by residents on hearing these alarms.

The two sirens will be tested at 14:30hrs and 19:30hrs. During this testing two different sounds will be heard alternately. The **COMAH Alarm** has a distinctive on/off sound (an intermittent tone) and the **All Clear Alarm** is a single continuous tone.
