RE: South Hook – Community Relations – COMAH Alarm Test

I am writing to inform you that as part of our continued commissioning process and safety communication, and in compliance with the legal requirements governing our facility, we will be testing two sirens on **Friday December 4th 2009**. One is the COMAH* Alarm and the other is the All Clear Alarm. No action need be taken by residents on hearing these alarms.

The two sirens will be tested between **10.00 – 13.00hrs on Friday 4th December 2009**. During this testing two different sounds will be heard alternately. The **COMAH Alarm** has a distinctive on/off sound (an intermittent tone) and the **All Clear Alarm** is a single continuous tone.
