

Control of Major Accident Hazards (COMAH) Regulations 1999

Notice to local residents within the **South Hook Public Information Zone (PIZ)**

At South Hook we take safety very seriously. It is our top priority.

As part of our continuing commissioning process and safety communications, and in compliance with the legal requirements governing our facility, we will be testing two sirens. One is the COMAH Alarm and the other is the All Clear Alarm.

NO ACTION NEED BE TAKEN BY LOCAL RESIDENTS

These two sirens will be tested between **10.00hrs to 13.00hrs** on **Friday 4th December 2009**.

During this testing two different sounds will be heard.

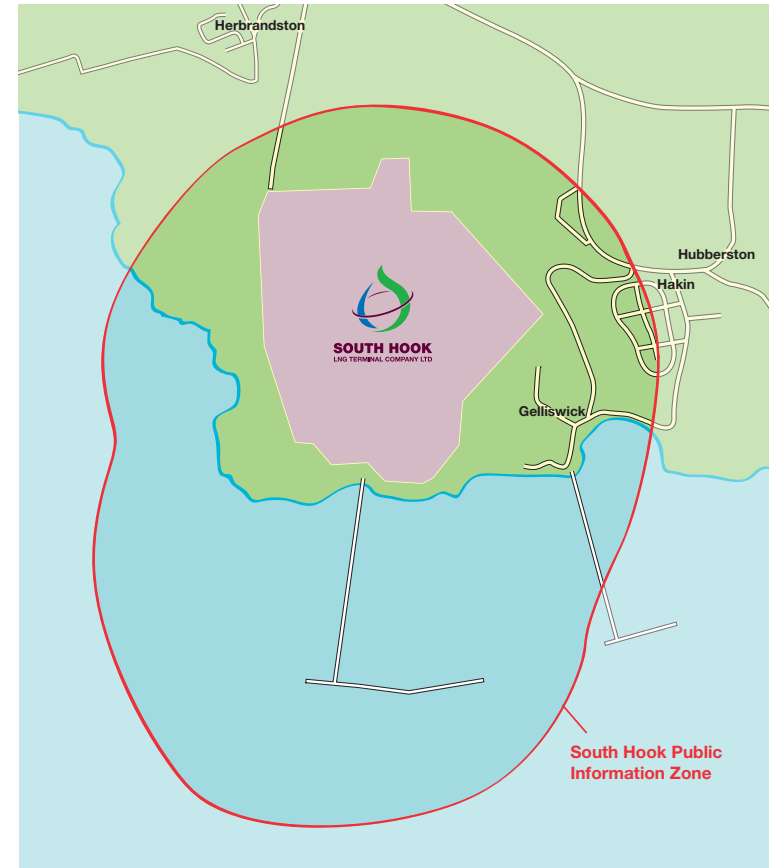
- The **COMAH Alarm** has a distinctive on/off sound – an **intermittent tone**.
- The **All Clear Alarm** is a single **continuous tone**.

During this 3 hour period the Alarms will be sounded alternately.

Important: this notice only applies to local residents within South Hook's PIZ as illustrated right.

The COMAH Alarm needs to be audible within the PIZ area. Please note that if you reside outside our PIZ area, (these areas include Herbrandston and beyond to the west, the outer limits of Hakin, Hubberston, Milford Haven and beyond to the east and Angle and beyond to the south) this notice does not apply to your area.
